

## The Top Five Findings from the 2014 United States Theft Report

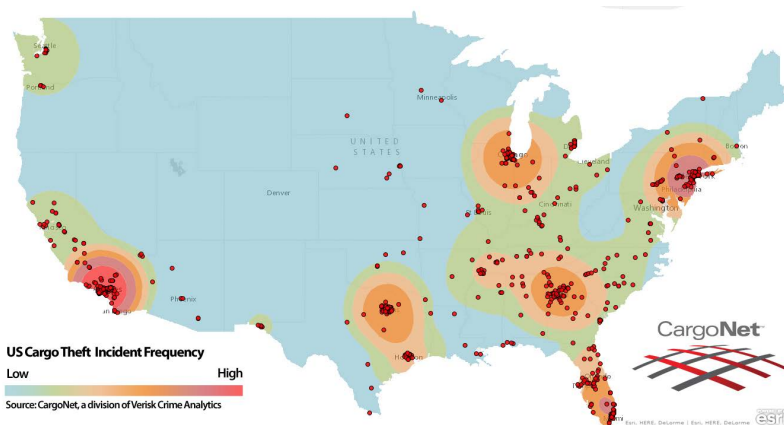
The transportation industry faces huge challenges in measuring the economic effects of cargo theft. CargoNet® has been recording highly detailed cargo theft reports since 2010 and now manages the nation's largest database of cargo theft incidents. Our 2014 United States Cargo Theft Report provides a comprehensive overview of American cargo theft from January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014. The report examines stolen commodity type; theft incident location, date, and time; cargo origin and destination; and mode of transportation. It also provides analysis gleaned from 144 specific theft data fields.

### Top five findings from the report

1. There were 205 reported cargo thefts in Q4 2014, down 31% from Q4 2013.
2. According to CargoNet data, October had the most cargo theft per month in 2014. In 2013, August had the most cargo theft per month.
3. CargoNet was able to determine an exact date of theft in 58% of cargo thefts that occurred in 2014.
4. Warehouse/DC locations experienced the most cargo theft this year. If fictitious pickups are factored out, truck stops experienced the most cargo theft.
5. Nearly 90 million dollars in cargo was stolen in 2014.

### 2014 US Cargo Theft Incident Frequency

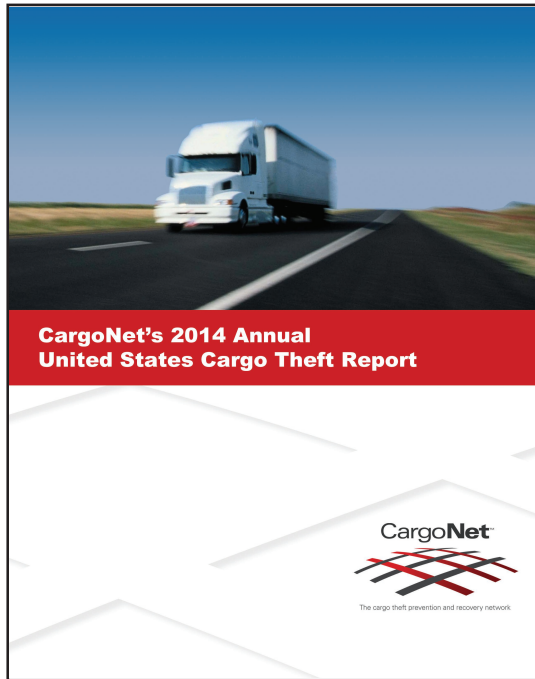
